Dear Ministry partners, family, and friends

I hope you are doing well during this time of national uncertainty. We know God is in charge and we hope this challenge has made your ministry stronger in the LORD. We want to keep you updated about your investment in our ministry.

During our summer months (January- February) we organized both a family camp and a youth camp with three churches participating. We were challenged by God's word and enjoyed great fellowship in an environment free from the distracting technologies that consume our lives. We are confident that next year we will double the attendance and have two more churches joining us.

From January to April I have been overseeing both the churches of Alto Hospicio and Iquique. I am preaching five times a week. Thankfully I have the help of some of the men of Iquique covering some of the services preaching in Alto Hospicio and also rotating some in Iquique.

We were looking forward to March, back-to-school month, and had many plans for new programs and other restarting. They involved an Easter choir, the youth program, the young married program, the Men's and Women's ministries and also discipleship.... but due to COVID 19, we have had to limit our ministries to the essentials.

We have decided to maintain services for Sunday morning and Wednesday for Iquique, and Sunday evening and Thursdays for Alto Hospicio for those who wish to attend in person. We will continue in-person services until they make the quarantine mandatory. The services are also sent online for those who decide it is not prudent to attend. We are active with our social media ministry to connect with those in need. Most churches have canceled their services through social pressure. By law, we are still allowed to meet in groups no larger than 50, but the Catholics, Mormons, the Evangelical Union and most Baptists have gone to online only.

Last week I had to perform a lady's funeral because no priests were performing ecclesiastical duties, through that I had the chance to lead an 87-year-old lady to Christ.

Keep us in prayer, my parents are trying to get back to the field and the window of opportunity is closing rapidly.

For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.
